School Uniform Policy

Streatley School is justifiably proud of its reputation within the community. Within the school itself, there exists an atmosphere which encourages effort, enjoyment and a celebration of the achievements of all our pupils. The school's concern for these high standards is also reflected in the pride we take in our school uniform.

In order to maintain a strong sense of identity and belonging within our school, we require all pupils to wear [labelled school uniform](#) which consists of:-

- Navy sweatshirt with school logo (available to order from the school)
- Navy cardigan with school logo (available to order from the school)
- White polo shirt tucked into trousers
- Standard grey school trousers
- [Grey skirt or grey pinafore – knee length](#)
- [Grey tights](#) (plain) or grey or white socks
- Wind and waterproof coat
- [Wellington boots](#) –no colour specified as variety makes them easier to find.
- Black, flat school shoes - heels no higher than 4 cm **inclusive** of any platform, lace ups or with 'T' bar or strap. Good examples below.

Items such as trousers, pinafores and polo shirts are all readily available in the high street - if parents find it difficult to obtain any items, please contact school or click on the hyperlinks.

Second Hand Uniform is also available and is sold through F.O.S.S. (Friends of Streatley School- see office for details).

Hair

Hair should be neat and tidy and worn with no extremes of style or colour or beading. All hair long enough to be tied up should be tied up to alleviate the problem of head lice and to save being caught in equipment. No hair products such as gel, mousse or dye are to be worn. Any hair accessories such as clips, slides or headbands should be plain blue, black, grey or white.

Other items not appropriate at school

No jewellery, make up, nail varnish or temporary tattoos should be worn. Should a pupil have pierced ears, plain studs only may be worn and in order to comply with health and safety regulations, must be covered or taken out during all PE activities.

Streatley School will respect variations to our school uniform if they are directly related to established religious traditions. However, any variation will be dealt with on an individual basis and judgements will remain at the discretion of the Headteacher and the Governing Board.
