The Institute of Physics (IOP) has invited us, in partnership with Curridge Primary School, to their summer festival "A celebration of physics: On the road to a sustainable world."

The event will be taking place on:
Wednesday 5th June 2024 (09.30 – 13.30)
at Silverstone, the legendary home of the British Grand Prix and MotoGP.

There will be talks, demonstrations and much more for the children to enjoy.

This event will include:

- A talk by Professor Carole Mundell, Director of Space (European Space Agency).
- Hands-on STEM workshops for students:
 - o Climate explorers: Unravelling the physics of weather & climate change.
 - o Zooming into the future with green transport.
- Opportunity to visit the expo and ask questions about physics and jobs with those working in local physics-related industry.
- Funded transportation to and from the event for your school.
- A bag of physics goodies for every teacher and student attending.
