



Key Instant Recall Facts

Year 1 – Summer 2

I know number bonds to 20.

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts **instantly**.

$0 + 20 = 20$	$20 + 0 = 20$
$1 + 19 = 20$	$19 + 1 = 20$
$2 + 18 = 20$	$18 + 2 = 20$
$3 + 17 = 20$	$17 + 3 = 20$
$4 + 16 = 20$	$16 + 4 = 20$
$5 + 15 = 20$	$15 + 5 = 20$
$6 + 14 = 20$	$14 + 6 = 20$
$7 + 13 = 20$	$13 + 7 = 20$
$8 + 12 = 20$	$12 + 8 = 20$
$9 + 11 = 20$	$11 + 9 = 20$
$10 + 10 = 20$	$10 + 10 = 20$

Key Vocabulary

What do I **add** to 5 to make 20?

What is 20 **take away** 6?

What is 3 **less than** 20?

How many more than 2 is 20?

They should be able to answer these questions in any order, including missing number questions e.g. $1 + \bigcirc = 20$ or $20 - \bigcirc = 8$.

Top Tips

The secret to success is practising **little** and **often**. Use time wisely. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey?
